Child Abuse Prevention Month

Hillsborough County ranks the highest in reported cases of child abuse in neglect in the state of Florida. Each day in our county, four children will be removed from their family homes due to child abuse and neglect, and half of those children will be under 5 years old. Once it occurs, the impact of child abuse and neglect extends far beyond childhood. It doesn't have to be this way.

By intervening early, Champions is working to prevent abuse and neglect before they even happen. We offer services for every family, from those who just need a little extra help to those who are deeply struggling with risk factors like substance abuse, health issues, domestic violence, financial hardship, or chronic stress. Regardless of the circumstance, we help parents and caregivers to become the best they can be so their child develops into the best person they can be — healthy, happy, productive members of society.
